



Severe Weather Arrangements

Dear Parents and Carers

Weather reports suggest that during this coming winter we can expect some severe weather conditions.

As a school, we need to be prepared for this and so I am writing to let you know of the arrangements during severe weather. My priority is the health and safety of both pupils and staff. If and when the snow arrives it could cause disruption on the roads. Members of staff who travel longer distances may not be able to get to school.

In the event of severe weather, I will make a decision by 8.00 am whether the school will open. **A text message will be sent out to advise parents whether school be open. Please ensure you have provided the school office with your up to date mobile number.** I will also pass this information to the following local radio stations:

- Pulse Radio
- Sunrise Radio
- FRESH AM

Please do not call the radio stations for information, they will broadcast details regularly.

Please make sure your child brings their coat to school every day. Some children are arriving in just their school sweatshirt. Unless the weather is really severe, the children are encouraged to get out into the fresh air and build the biggest snowman possible!!
