On Tuesday 17th April 2018 we had an Ofsted Inspection. It was a Section 8 (1 day) safeguarding inspection. This was carried out by two HMI's (Her Majesty's Inspectors) and two lead inspectors.

The day itself was quite intense and they thoroughly inspected all our work, including safeguarding arrangements at the school. The inspectors knew that we had been judged as outstanding in 2010. They informed us that during the day if they felt that the standards had dropped, then the inspection would be converted into a Section 5 (2 day) inspection.
