Dear Parents/Carers

Positive Covid-19 Results During the Holiday

It is important that you inform us of positive cases of Covid for any of our pupils particularly at the start of the holidays and **up to and including 24th December 2020**. As this will mean that, they and their teacher and rest of the class may need to isolate to protect themselves and others. If this should happen, please email the information to covidsupport@iqra.bradford.sch.uk Please provide the confirmation you receive from NHS / Track and Trace - your child's name, date of birth, class, postcode and a contact number for us to contact you on should we need to.

From 24th December, there is no need to notify the school immediately, however your household should isolate for the number of days advised by the NHS / Track and Trace (currently 10 days after the result or symptoms starting).

School will reopen to pupils who are well and not suffering from any Covid symptoms on **Tuesday 5th January 2021**. Children who have Covid symptoms themselves or have tested positive or who live with others in their household who have symptoms or who have tested positive and are under isolation instructions, should not attend school and you should report their absence in the normal way. This can be done from Monday 4th January 2021 when our Office will reopen.

Holiday Food Programme

The Holiday Food Programme is part of the support provided by the government for vulnerable households to have access to food for the 2 week Christmas Holiday period (20th December to 3rd January including Christmas Day and New Year's Day) and the February half term period (1 week). This will be provided by voluntary organisations. Please see the attached list.

Food provision type will vary between organisations but will include hot food, packed lunches, hampers, food packs etc. Please contact the organisations directly for further information.
