Punctuality

Please ensure pupils arrive to school on time. The gates open at 8.50am and close at 9.00am. Pupils arriving late miss vital learning and disrupt the rest of the class.

Covid Updates

There has been an update on the Covid close contact rules. All adults who are fully vaccinated and children aged 5 to 18 years and 6 months, If you are notified by NHS Test and Trace as a close contact, you should take an LFD each day for 7 days, instead of isolating. And report the results through the Online Reporting System and to their setting. If they test negative, they can continue to attend school.

If they test positive, they should self-isolate and order a PCR test to confirm the result. If the PCR is positive, they must self-isolate for 10 days. If the PCR test is negative, they no longer need to self-isolate but should continue to carry out the remainder of the daily tests, and only need to isolate if it is positive.

The cost of a meal is £1.90 per day (£9.50 per week). If pupil's accounts are in debt the kitchen will be unable to provide a school dinner. Pupils will need to bring packed lunch or go home for lunch until their account is brought up to date.
